WHAT DOES BEING A VOLUNTEER AT GOODWOOD INVOLVE?

You will be required to undertake one 6-hour unpaid shift, either AM or PM, over each event day. You will be able to specify your preference which we will endeavour to accommodate where possible.

If you would like to volunteer with friends or family, please let us know and we can make sure you are stationed together!

PLEASE NOTE Volunteers will be required to have a fully-refundable deposit taken, equal to the value of an adult weekend ticket (prices below). This is in order to prevent people gaining entry with their wristband and not arriving for their shifts! Providing that all shifts have been completed, the deposit will be returned at Staff HQ at the end of the last volunteering shift.

Paddock Marshals (Revival)

Oversee the running of the paddock gates whilst being at the centre of all the action!
